- ◆ **A black and white or color photograph – at least 4” X 6”**
- ◆ **Submit a response to the question, “What constitutes leadership?” Essay should be word processed and double spaced in 12-point Times New Roman font with 1-inch margins around; essay should not exceed three pages.**
- ◆ **Three letters of reference referring to your leadership potential: One from your chapter advisor, one from the Director of Greek Life, and one from a professor in your field of study.**

Who can apply?

Undergraduate members in good standing within the fraternity and college/university community are eligible to apply for consideration. Graduates or students not returning to their campuses for the 2006-07 academic year are ineligible to apply.
