Nixon, who assumed the role in December, joins four other new staff members at International Headquarters (IHQ) since the beginning of the 2023-2024 fraternal year.

Reporting to the Director of Undergraduate and University Affairs, Nixon will support the success and sustainability of undergraduate chapters, collaborating with the Provinces and individual chapters, and serving as the liaison between university personnel [fraternity/sorority-life professional(s)] and IHQ.

“Daniel’s remarkable blend of leadership skills and teamwork will complement our work at IHQ and the fraternity overall,” said John F. Burrell. “His experience spans several diverse roles and has prepared him for this important position. I look forward to his contributions and new ideas as we continue to nurture and support our undergraduate members and our interaction with institutions of higher learning.”

In addition to collecting and managing undergraduate demographic data and planning undergraduate-related events for the Grand Chapter Meeting, Nixon will assist Province leadership with the expansion of undergraduate chapters and reestablishing/activating chapters at colleges and universities nationally and abroad, among many other duties.

Prior to joining the team at IHQ, Nixon was a world class athlete in track and field (800 meters) running for the Adidas/Atlanta Track Club. While competing professionally, he collaborated and served on national sports committees of USA Track & Field and TrackTown USA, contributing to their national marketing strategies. Nixon also served as a board member for the National Amateur Fall Baseball Federation, playing a key role in governance, strategic direction, and financial management. Before working in athletics, Nixon supported one of the nation’s top re-entry programs in Alabama where he helped program participants obtain high school diplomas and General Educational Development (GED).



Nixon is a Spring 2018 initiate of the Mississippi State University Chapter, the Eta Upsilon of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. where he served as Vice Polemarch. He served the 34th Administration as an Undergraduate Grand Board of Directors Member and is the 98th Guy L. Grant Awardee. Nixon is a Grand Chapter Life Member and currently serves as a chair for the National Achievement Academy. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration and a Master of Science degree in Financial Planning from Iowa State University.
